Approval of December FAS Board Minutes

Marianne asked for a motion for approval of the December 2024 FAS Board meeting minutes, Del Kleinschmidt made a motion to approve, Anita Koester seconded the motion. All were in favor of the motion, none were opposed, the minutes are approved.

Resolution of Posting Meeting Notices

Gabriella Bommer shared that there is a resolution notifying where the posting for Board meeting notices will be. They will be posted on the website, and as an alternate location if the website is not accessible, they will be posted outside the Hope Center for Humane Education door. Carly Lorentz made a motion to approve this resolution of posting meeting notices, Del seconded the motion, there were no further comments, all voted in favor, the motion passed.

December Financials

Lea Araki summarized the financials. On the P&L, 2024 ended \$30,000 over budget in earned income. This if from community services such as from Adoptions and End-of-Life services and the Vaccine Clinics. We did not receive all of the bequests that we had budgeted. Licensing revenue was a bit higher than expected. In Expenses, we have been more conscientious in 2024 over all our controllable expenses, especially with respect to our budgeted net income. We chose not to backfill some of the staff vacancies to help make up for some of the bequests that knew we might not receive; this allowed us to come in under budget for the year and to help cover that small deficit

that was proposed for the 2025 budget. The net income of \$34,000 covers the forecasted budget. Considering that Q1 is historically a lower revenue time for Foothills, the plan amongst Shelter leadership is to continue to manage our payroll and operational expenses conservatively.

On the Balance Sheet, the only major change is assets moving from Cash to Building Improvements for that Long Term Holding renovation. We had one additional bill due at the end of December, so those funds will move from that Reserve account to the Building & Improvement line.

December Licensing Report

Lea shared that December & Year to Date numbers show a continued downward trend of licensing participation across all municipalities and as a whole. In Expenses, December was higher than average due to printing and copying costs covers one-quarter's worth have been paid. The final YTD total for Licensing Administrative Costs for 2024 is \$85,930; this does not include the additional Licensing Specialist and the management of the program. The 2025 Assessment amount in the packet is what can be expected to be invoiced to each jurisdiction. All of the 2025 assessment numbers should be less than projected in the November report because December did outperform the forecast.

Action item: Lea to send invoices for assessments out later today.

Fee Schedule Approval

Maggie McSchaefer introduced a new line item on the Fee Schedule to add a charge of \$10 now for dewormer product so we can charge for it on court case invoices and provide it at our Vaccine Clinics moving forward. Gabriella made a motion to approve adding dewormer to the Fee Schedule, Anita seconded the motion, there were no additional comments, all voted in favor, the motion passes.

Executive Director Report

Maggie informed everyone that Long Term Holding is now completed, and we can have access to that room now regardless of the weather conditions. We are hiring for a couple of mid-level manager positions right now, they are both looking for a credentialed and experienced person, so we expect them to take some time to fill, which should help with our goal to be conservative in our payroll costs this year. Western Roofing has agreed to cover the cost of roof maintenance and inspection for the Shelter, we will be highlighting them in our Annual Report. We will be closing on February 5th for a deep-cleaning day, we will still be open for reclaims and stray intakes. Our team will be onsite for Animal Control if they need support that day as well.

News from the Friends of Foothills Animal Shelter team is that Community Shares of Colorado has announced their need to dissolve, we typically get about \$75,000 annually to the Shelter from them so we are working on what this will look like for those donors moving forward. Colorado Gives Day raised almost \$75,000 more than in 2023. The November/December end of year fundraising was steady with the prior year. The dog Butterfly was featured, we saw a great response from the community around her story.

Mediation Update

Marianne provided an update to the mediation happening between Foothills and the Jefferson County Sheriff's Office. We have been able to schedule a meeting on February 13th from 1-5 PM at

the Golden Community Center. Attendees will include the same folks from the first mediation plus Patrick Goff to represent the City Managers and Carly Lorentz to represent the FAS Board.

Additional Items

Gabriella introduced Commander Anthony Baros as Arvada's alternate Board Member. Del Kleinschmidt introduced himself as the new Board Member for Jefferson County.

Shelter Updates

Our next new volunteer onboarding sessions are upcoming on February 26th and March 1st.

FAS participated in 2nd mediation session with Jeffco on Thursday 2/13, and a smaller follow-up session on Tuesday 2/25.

Reminder, our next meeting in March is a joint meeting with the Friends board and will be held in person at the shelter.

Friends Updates

Our Medical Appeal Matching Gift Challenge, sponsored by Firstbank has generated more than \$25k in February (1-18) with 300 donors. In 2024, our Medical Appeal from the same period raised \$13k and 170 donors.

The Development team is planning 2 larger community events - save the dates!

5/15 - After Hours - this event will include adult beverages and appetizers and will be hosted at the shelter - geared towards our adult supporters.

9/13 - Community Event - this event is a broader community event, family friendly day with booth vendors, food trucks, games and activities, and shelter tours, it will be hosted next door at the Fairgrounds - geared towards families and a wider audience of current and potential supporters. We will also be encouraging peer-to-peer fundraising to earn special edition FAS prizes!

Our online recurring giving program, the PAW program, has increased from \$7k monthly in 2024 to \$9.2k in January 2025. For 2025 we plan even further expansion in donor appreciation and recruitment efforts to encourage more patrons to support through recurring giving.
