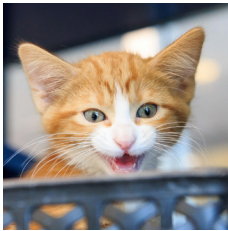

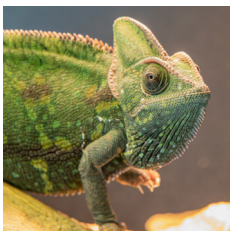

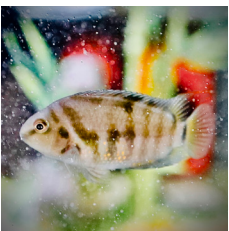

THE VALUE OF OUR VOLUNTEERS

Every Thursday, rain or shine, a dedicated group of volunteers reports to the Foothills Community Room for our weekly low-cost Vaccine Clinic. These compassionate individuals make an immense difference in the health of pets across Jefferson County.

Our clinics ensure pet owners have access to essential preventative care for their companions and these volunteers guide patrons through every step of the process while creating a welcoming and supportive environment for all who attend.

A POSITIVE EXPERIENCE

From the moment pet owners arrive, they are greeted with warm smiles and friendly faces. Our volunteers play a crucial role in our clinics from start to finish: checking in patrons and their pets, assisting with necessary paperwork, and guiding them through the vaccination process.

PROGRAM HIGHLIGHT

TRANSFER PROGRAM

Foothills Animal Shelter is proud to play a vital role in the broader animal welfare community of Colorado through our robust transfer program. In 2024, we collaborated with 45 partner organizations across the state, transferring in 880 animals from throughout Colorado in need of specialized behavior or medical care or a fresh start.

SUPPORTING PARTNER SHELTERS

We are grateful our community's support allows us to assist our transfer partners by providing temporary relief when they are facing overcrowding or programmatic challenges. Transferred animals ensure Foothills can provide our community with options when they consider adoption, and create elbow room for source partners to prepare for the needs of future arrivals. We share a collective mission to do more for pets in Colorado, and only together can we all thrive.



PROVIDING SPECIALIZED CARE

Our skilled veterinary team expertly delivers medical care for transferred pets, helping set them on their road home. Our experienced behavior team provides individualized plans and enrichment programs, helping pets feel safe and flourish during these difficult transitional periods. Equipped with helpful tools and resources, adopters are set up for success when they welcome home their new companions.

EXPANDING ADOPTION OPPORTUNITIES

We all need a change of scenery sometimes. The same can be true of pets seeking a new home. Our community welcomes these pets with open arms, providing critical support of their care making these transfer efforts possible.

For pets like Jupiter, a fresh start was just the thing she needed. Jupiter had been patiently waiting to meet her new people at another Colorado shelter for some time. After she was transferred to Foothills, Jupiter found a loving family of her own the very next day!

This collaborative approach benefits both animals and people across Colorado. We are able to build a stronger animal welfare network through our transfer partnerships.
